## Your human rights are:

- ★ The right to life.
- ★ Freedom from torture and degraded treatment.
- $\star$  Freedom from slavery and forced labour.
- ★ The right to liberty.
- $\star$  The right to a fair trial.
- $\star$  The right not to be punished for something that wasn't a crime when you did it.
- $\star$  The right to respect for private and family life.
- ★ Freedom of thought, conscience and religion.
- $\star$  Freedom of expression.
- ★ Freedom of assembly and association.
- $\star$  The right to marry or form a civil partnership and start a family.
- $\star$  The right not to be discriminated against in respect of these rights and freedoms.
- ★ The right to own property.
- $\star$  The right to an education.
- $\star$  The right to participate in free elections.
